

NUS-RENMIN MSRE-MBA DDP Application Guidelines

ADMISSION CRITERIA

The DDP admission criteria satisfy all the criteria of the existing NUS-MSRE and RENMIN-MBA programmes. Specifically, the candidates must:

- 1. Possess a good honours degree (or equivalent) in a relevant discipline.
- 2. At least two years of relevant work experience upon completion of bachelor's degree.
- 3. Applicants whose medium of undergraduate instruction was not English will need to submit the TOEFL or IELTS result as evidence of language proficiency. The proficiency will be determined by the TOEFL score of at least 580-600 (paper-based test), 237-250 (computer-based test) or 85 (internet-based test), or an IELTS result of at least 6.0.
- 4. Applicants who are <u>China nationals</u> must pass China's national MBA admission examination. For RBS IMBA current students and alumni who apply for DDP NUS MSRE part study, an official recommendation letter from RBS is required as the supporting document.
- 5. Applicants of <u>other nationalities</u> are recommended to submit the GMAT result. Admission is decided by a Joint Admission Panel comprising faculty members from both NUS Department of Real Estate and Renmin University School of Business.

Remarks:

- For RBS IMBA current students and alumni whose medium of instruction during their undergraduate studies was not in English, and fulfill the rest of the entry requirement of applying NUS-Renmin MSRE-MBA DDP, NUS Board of Selection (BOS) will decide whether the candidate needs to take TOEFL/IELTS and/or CELC's DET test. Candidates who sit and fail the DET test will need to take the CELC course(s) and pass the module(s) as a graduation requirement.
 - # CELC: Centre for English Language Communication
 - # DET: Diagnostic English test

The shortlisted candidates will be given individual result with advice on their English language test.

GMAT is recommended but not compulsory.

• Interview Process (27th June 2017) via Skype with NUS Professors

Step 4

• Results are announced by 6th July 2017. Official email as the Letter of Offer will be sent to students and RBS MBA Program Center

• Deadline to accept/decline offer: 12th July 2017. New students have to confirm the Acceptance of Offer and settle the acceptance fees via Cashier's Order/Credit Card/Bank

For international students, NUS will assist them for the following administrative and logistic for their overseas study. More details will be released to NUS-Renmin MSRE-MBA candidates.

- In-Principle Approval Letter (IPA), the one way entry visa to Singapore NUS will apply IPA and send it via email once SOLAR application is approved by the Immigration and Checkpoints Authority (ICA)
